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What You'll See - Highlights

The adventure begins in Athens, the centerpiece of western civilization. Athens offers much to the returning or new visitor. Consider arriving a day or two early, either before or after the cruise (or both!) to explore the city's many wonders. Architecturally, Athens houses the jewel of the Parthenon. A marvel of engineering, the Parthenon silently rules over all. You've seen it in movies and photos, but to walk up the Hill of the Acropolis, stand before it and experience its energy, majesty and strength is an experience you owe to yourself. There are Museums with ancient artifacts that are centuries older than our entire country, art, ruins, and history are scattered throughout the city. Yet, Athens is also an energetic city with a boisterous nightlife (think plate throwing), dancing, music, food, shopping and endless streets to ramble. Do take some of this in before we head to Piraeus, the busy port of Athens to board the Silver Whisper which will be our home for the next 7 nights.

Pristine Paros will be our first port. Clusters of white houses and windmills dot the landscape. Most are built around the Church of A Hundred Doors. 99 Doors have reportedly been found. Legend says when the 100th door is discovered Constantinople will rejoin Greece. Paros' fame for centuries has been its translucent marble. The Venus di Milo statue which currently resides in Le Louvre was carved from this marble. We're on to Rhodes which housed the Knights of St. John for over 200 years. You can tour the Knights' Hospital and Palace of the Grand Masters if ancient artifacts are of interest. Cicero and Caesar studied here at the School of Rhetoric. Rhodes' Old Town is a lively medieval village that is easy to stroll, shop, choose an outdoor taverna and enjoy people watching over a glass of ouzo. History shares this small space easily. Patmos is primarily known for its religious significance as the writing place of The Revelations of St. John which were written while St. John was exiled from the Roman Empire. John was also known as John of Patmos and is thought to be John the Apostle, a favorite Apostle of Jesus. He along with other convicts

were exiled to this island during religious persecution. The cave in which he lived is close to the Monastery of St. John built on the island's highest peak. The Turkish city Bodrum is a glorious holiday resort on the peninsula. White houses and pink bougainvillea dominate the landscape while luxury hotels, and beaches provide the perfect playground for water sports galore. Known as the exclusive part of the Turkish Riviera, wealth is the price of admission and the people watching is fabulous. This is the place to relax, take in some sun, sand and sea - all while picking out which yacht is for you! Symi, a mere 23 square mile island packs quite a bit into its small size. Besides what is considered to be, a "Perfect Port", there are museums to visit, hiking paths for all levels of ability but all with spectacular views, a Monastery popular with travelers around the world to pray for health and protection, windmills and wonderful beaches. Pick and choose... there's so many ways to enjoy your time here. Our final stop before we return to Piraeus is Amorgos Island. Beaches, cliffs, bays and sweeping beauty define this local. It is said the water here is "a million shades of blue" and crystal clear. A Monastery appears to hang off one of the cliffs 300 meters above the sea, but doesn't stop pilgrims from making the walk up. Sea and sky seem to meet along the many hiking paths, hence their name, the Blue Paths.

This collection of eclectic islands provides a rare opportunity to indulge your senses and enjoy a taste of the Greek Isles, its culture, its food, its clear blue waters and its people from a perspective beyond the more known islands. Come enjoy this Island life on the beautiful Mediterranean waters. If this is where the Greeks and Turks choose to vacation, don't you want to be there too?

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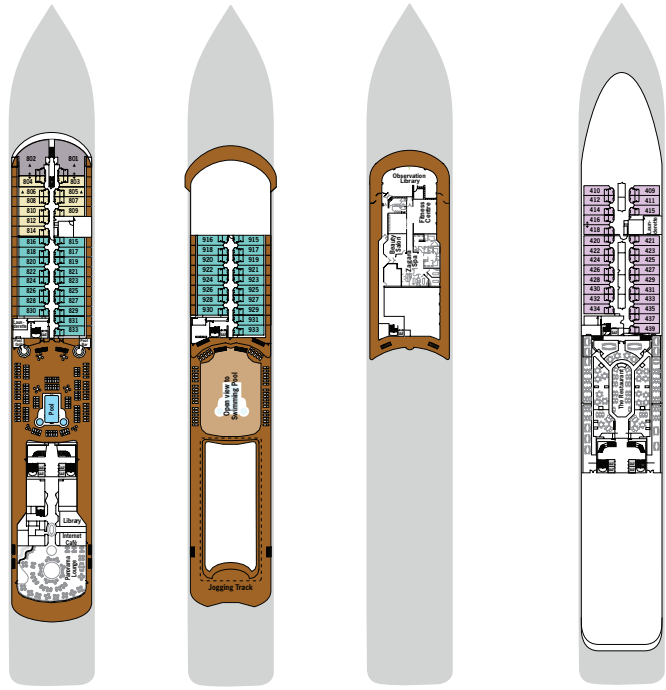

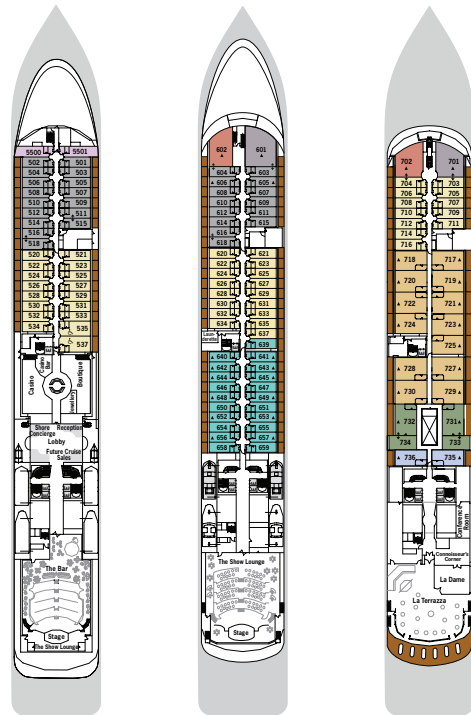
